Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., so as to issue appropriate directions to respondent Nos.1 to 4 for registration of FIR against private respondent Nos.5 to 8 and to take appropriate legal action against them.

Learned State Counsel has filed the status report by way of affidavit of Ms. Navneet Kaur Gill, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, (Headquarters), Nawanshahar, District SBS Nagar dated 21.01.2020, on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4, which is taken on record. She refers to paragraph 6 of the status report to contend that after thorough inquiry, it has been found that the petitioner is in the habit of moving frivolous complaints against her creditors and the petitioner herself admitted that she has taken a

petitioner against private respondent Nos.5 to 8 was politically motivated as the same was moved at the instance of Santokh Singh @ Tukka and Parminder Kumar Menka @ Bhinda, who are political rivals of respondent No.5.

In view of the status report so filed by learned State Counsel, this Court finds that filing of the present petition is totally frivolous and has been filed in order to settle the score with private respondent Nos.5 to 8.

Accordingly, the present petition is hereby dismissed with costs of ₹10,000/- to be paid by the petitioner, within a period of one month from today with the Poor Patients' Welfare Fund of **Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research, Chandigarh.**
