The present petition has been filed by the petitioner-M/s S.L.V. Security Services Pvt. Ltd., *inter alia*, praying for quashing of the award dated 22.11.2011 (Annexure P-10).

Vide order dated 03.04.2019, parties were directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Today on resumed hearing of the case, both the parties are in agreement to submit that vide written settlement/agreement dated 07.05.2019, the matter has been compromised. It is so recorded in the compromise that both the parties have mutually agreed that the first party shall pay a sum of Rs.1 lakh towards full and final settlement of the dispute to the second party.

This Court is, therefore, of the view that no further orders are called for.

Writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous in view of the agreement.
