The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.249 dated 22.09.2020 under Sections 452, 379, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

The operative part of the order dated 16.10.2020, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioners, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per allegations in the FIR, blow on head of the complainant is attributed to petitioner No.1 and a kirpan blow on his left wrist is attributed to petitioner No.2. It is further submitted that without prejudice to their right of defence, the petitioners are ready to compensate the victim/complainant by paying Rs.50,000/-.

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that, in pursuance

to the order dated 16.10.2020, the petitioners have appeared before the Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation and also handed over the demand draft of Rs.50,000/- favouring the complainant to the Investigating Officer.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Karnail Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 16.10.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
