For the reasons mentioned in the application, which is duly supported by an affidavit, the same is allowed. Consequently, delay of 28 days in filing the accompanying appeal is condoned.

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Having heard learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the State of Haryana and having perused the order passed by the authorities, we are of the considered opinion that no case is made out for entertaining this appeal, as the learned Single Judge has referred the matter back to the authorities for taking a decision on the application of the petitioner-respondent regarding pre-mature release and, in the meantime, has granted interim bail.

Learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, on instructions, submits that the matter is still pending before the authorities. He, however, states that a decision thereon would be taken within two weeks.

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Taking the statement of the learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, on record, the appeal is disposed of, directing the authorities to decide the case of the petitioner-respondent for premature release within two weeks and communicate the same to the person concerned. It goes without saying that the order granting interim bail would be subject to the decision taken by the authorities.
