Matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

As per pleadings on record, the husband as also son of the petitioner stand implicated in FIR No.0245, dated 21.09.2020, registered at Police Station Sadar Jalandhar.

Grievance raised in the instant petition is that merely on account of registration of the FIR, the police authorities concerned are harassing the petitioner who happens to be a lady and are preventing her as also her staff/servant from entering in their agricultural land and to harvest the ripe crop standing thereupon. It has further been alleged that the police/authorities are not even permitting them to use their combine harvester as also tractor/other implements.

In the light of the grievance raised in the petition and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I

deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach the 3rd respondent i.e. the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar with regard to the grievance as noticed herein above.

In the eventuality of the petitioner submitting a representation/ grievance petition confined to the aspect of her being prevented from harvesting the crop and attending to her agricultural land, the 3rd respondent would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and warranted in accordance with law.
