The case has been taken up through video conferencing due to the prevailing situation of Covid-19.

The petitioner has filed this petition to restrain the respondents No.3 to 5 from dispossessing the petitioner from the land in question during the pendency of the revision petition with stay application bearing ROR No.452 of 2020 (Annexure P-3) till the decision of the stay application.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the revision petition is pending before respondent No.1 and after 12.10.2020, no date has been given to the petitioner by the Revisional Authority and even no order has been passed on the stay application. Leaned counsel has further submitted that if the operation of orders (Annexures P-1 and P-2) is not stayed, the petitioner will loose the possession over the concerned land and in that situation, the petition of the petitioner will be rendered infructuous.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, the petition is hereby disposed of without entering into the merits of the case, with

direction to respondent No.1-Financial Commissioner Revenue to dispose of the stay application filed by the petitioner, within 15 days, from the date of receipt of copy of this order and also to dispose of the revision petition expeditiously preferably, within a period of 3 months, from the date of receipt of copy of this order and till the decision of the stay application by respondent No.1, status quo regarding possession over the land in question as is on today, shall be maintained.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of.
