The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of directions to respondent Nos.5 to 7 to take all necessary steps to remove the alleged illegal/ wrong median cuts in Rajpura on Ludhiana-Ambala National Highway as according to the petitioners such cuts are causing accidents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that at this stage she would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice dated 16.07.2020 (Annexure P3) sent on behalf of the petitioners.

I find the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners to be reasonable.

Accordingly the present petition is disposed of with a

direction to respondent Nos.2, 3, 5 to 7 to form a committee and to consider and take action as is deemed fit in accordance with law on the aforesaid legal notice sent on behalf of the petitioners. The needful be done within two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

It is clarified that the aforesaid directions have been given by this Court without going into the merits of the issues raised by the petitioners in their legal notice as also the present petition.
