Final result of the petitioner for the post of Shift Attendant against advertisement No.03/2016 category No.01 in the SC category has been produced in sealed cover alongwith the marks obtained by the last selected candidate/candidate on waiting list in the respective category in UHVBNL/DHBVNL.

2. Result of the petitioner on opening shows the petitioner to have secured 86 out of 200 marks besides, has been treated not eligible on scrutiny of documents whereas the last selected candidate in UHVBNL/DHBVNL secured 89 marks while the last selected candidate on the waiting list secured 87 marks.

3. Result as well as the marks obtained by the last selected candidate/candidate on the waiting list have been shown to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof, states that she does not wish to

press the writ petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

5. Result be resealed and returned to learned Sr. DAG, Haryana.
