All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner being that 130 gms. of opium were recovered from him, which is far below commercial quantity, and there being no other criminal case registered against him, he deserves to be admitted to bail.

Learned State counsel while otherwise opposing the grant of bail, could not deny the factual position and, as per his instructions, there is no other criminal case registered against the petitioner.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of

the case, the petition is allowed, with the petitioner ordered to be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
