Counsel for the petitioners states that in the light of the order dated 25.07.2016 (Annexure R-1) passed by The Director of Public Instructions (SE), Punjab-respondent No. 2, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous. He, however, prays for liberty on behalf of the petitioners to file a representation to put forth their claim with regard to the arrears, if any, within a period of four weeks.

In case such a representation is made, the same shall be considered and decided by The Director of Public Instructions (SE), Punjab-respondent No. 2 within a period of further six weeks. In case the claim of the petitioners is accepted, the consequential benefits be released to them within four weeks thereafter.

Writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
