The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing in the light of the pandemic COVID-19 situation and as per instructions.

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the appeal dated 02.09.2020 (Annexure P-2), in a time-bound manner.

Contents that the appeal of the petitioner filed under Clause 16 of the Punjab Labour and Cartage Policy (2020-21) against the decision of the District Tender Allotment Committee, Faridkot conveyed through technical summary dated 11.08.2020 and uploaded on 13.08.2020, whereby, the technical bid submitted by the petitioner has been rejected in an illegal and arbitrary manner.

Heard.

Considering the nature of prayer made, we are not inclined to issue notice of motion. A complete copy of the paper-book has already been supplied to learned State counsel.

Accordingly, without adverting to the merits of the case, respondent No.2 is directed to take up the appeal preferred by the petitioner and to decide the same expeditiously, preferably, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, after affording effective opportunity of hearing to the petitioner or its representative.
