Petitioner is seeking quashing of the order dated 18.06.2015 (Annexure P-3), whereby his services have been terminated.

Petitioner was appointed as driver on contract basis through Daksh Detective & Security Services (P) Ltd. In this regard, copy of certificate dated 01.08.2014 has been attached as Annexure P-1. However, the petitioner was not allowed to work after 05.06.2015. In para No.4 of the petition, petitioner has given details of the attendant in the month of June, 2015. Case of the petitioner is that after 05.06.2015, he was not allowed to join his duty.

Upon notice, reply on behalf of respondents has been filed, wherein it has been clarified that as per first agreement, the petitioner was engaged as driver w.e.f. 08.08.2014 to 07.02.2015. The second agreement was executed w.e.f. 07.2.2015 to 06.08.2015 and during this period, petitioner remained

absent from 05.06.2015 onwards. Thereafter, his services were terminated

on 18.06.2015. In response to the contents mentioned in para No.4 of the petition, the respondents have clarified that even, as per attendance rolls of June, 2015, he willfully remained absent from 05.06.2015 onwards.

The petitioner was a contractual employee and keeping in view his absence from duty, his services have been terminated. Hence, no right accrues to him to join the department after a gap of almost four months.

No merits. Dismissed.
