Petitioners have filed this writ petition under Articles 226/227 Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from respondent Nos.4 and 5 as they have solemnized marriage on 14.10.2020 against their wishes.

On 20.10.2020, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are receiving threats from respondent Nos.4 and 5 as they have entered into marriage on 14.10.2020 against the wishes of private respondents.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3 only, at this stage.

Mr. Ramandeep Sandhu, Sr.DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of official respondents. Counsel for the petitioners undertakes to forward the complete copy of the petition to the office of Advocate General Punjab through e-mail, during the course of the day. Learned State counsel prays for time to verify the facts and the

existence of alleged threat.
On joint request, adjourned to 03.11.2020.”

Learned State counsel has apprised that statements of petitioners have been recorded wherein they have stated that they are happily residing at Jagowal Bangar, District Gurdaspur and they have no threat from private respondents.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners states that petition is rendered infructuous.
