The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID-19.

The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents for making paddy allotment to the petitioner firm for shelling for the year 2020-2021

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is aggrieved of the action of the respondent in not allotting paddy to the firm of the petitioner for the shelling. He further states that the petitioner would submit a representation before respondent No.2-The Director Food Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Department of Food Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Anaj Bhawan, Sector-39C, Chandigarh detailing his claim. The petitioner may do so on or before 19.10.2020.

In view of the above, respondent No.2 is directed to consider and decide the representation within a period of 4 days as and when received, considering that the process of allotment of the paddy is under way.
