The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that similar matter has been decided by a coordinate Bench of this court in CWP No.7551 of 2018 titled as Subash Chander Vs. State of Punjab and others, decided on 06.12.2018. He submits that he will be satisfied if representation (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner is decided by respondent No.2 within a time prescribed by this court.

Mr. Nikhil Chopra, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. He has not raised any objection in this regard and has rather fairly submitted that the representation dated 11.05.2020 (Annexures P-2) shall be decided by respondent No.2 in accordance with law.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the

representation dated 11.5.2020 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, by passing a speaking order and affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and in view of judgment in CWP No.7551 of 2018.
