Through this writ petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner challenges the correctness of the impugned order, whereby he has been transferred to an adjoining district, i.e., from the Government Central Training Institute (Women), Sirsa, to the Government Central Training Institute (Women) Piyao Majra, Hisar.

It is not in dispute that the petitioner is appointed on a post which is transferable. Earlier, the petitioner was transferred to Sirsa. He filed CWP-6933-2020, challenging his transfer to Sirsa, in which notice of motion was issued. During the pendency of the writ petition, the petitioner applied for transfer to Hisar, which has been accepted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that earlier the petitioner opted for Jind, however, later on, he was forced to change his

option. However, there is no material in support thereof. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute that the petitioner has himself opted for Hisar.

In view thereof, there is no ground to interfere.

Dismissed.
