

**INDIAN EX SERVICEMEN MOVEMENT
VS
STATE OF HARYANA AND OTHERS**

Present: Mr. ADS Jattana, Advocate for the petitioner.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic, COVID-19.

The petitioner seeks review of order dated 18.02.2020, vide which the impugned order dated 12.03.2019 (Annexure P-10) has been set aside and the matter remitted to the State Registrar of Societies, Haryana to be decided afresh, after affording appropriate opportunity of hearing to the parties concerned.

The petitioner is seeking review on the ground that the State Registrar of Societies, Haryana, does not have the jurisdiction to decide the matter at all. Therefore, the matter should not be remanded for a decision afresh by him and moreover, there is no provision of a second appeal in terms of Section 79 of the Haryana Registration and Regulation of Societies Act, 2012.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, I do not find any ground to review order dated 18.02.2020. Needless to say, the question regarding jurisdiction would be decided by the authority concerned and in respect to any observation in the said order regarding remedy of appeal being available to the parties, it is necessarily to be treated as an observation for decision of the said matter only and not an adjudication on merits.

The review petition is accordingly dismissed.
