This is second petition for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in a criminal case arising from FIR No.86, dated 12.11.2019, registered under Sections 22/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Balianwali, District Bathinda, Punjab.

First application for grant of bail, filed by the petitioner, was dismissed by this Court vide order 10.06.2020, which is extracted as under:-

“The petitioner prays for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.86 dated 12.11.2019 registered under Sections 22,61,85 NDPS Act at Police Station Balianwali, District Bathinda, Punjab.

As per the case of the prosecution, petitioner was apprehended with 700 intoxicated tablets of Clovidol-100

SR. The total weight of the 700 tablets is 287.95 grams. Report of the Forensic Science Laboratory has been received confirming that prohibited substance Tramadol hydrochloride was found in the intoxicated tablets. The quantity recovered falls within the definition of the commercial quantity punishable with imprisonment for a period of not less than 10 years. In view of bar under Section 37 of the NDPS Act, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of bail to the petitioner.

Hence, the present petition is hereby dismissed.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner failed to draw the attention of the Court to any changed circumstances.

Hence, no ground to grant bail to the petitioner is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
