1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.0144 dated 18.12.2019 registered at Police Station Tarsikka, District Amritsar Rural, under Sections 452, 324, 295, 506, 148, 149 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 27.10.2020, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Baba Bakala Sahib, has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of accused/petitioners Narinder Singh, Paramjit Kaur,

Dalbir Singh and Jaskiran Kaur @ Kirandeep Kaur and also of complainant Harpreet Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. The complainant Harpreet Singh in his statement has stated that he has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. The learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Baba Bakala Sahib, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise without any pressure, coercion or undue pressure and the same appears to be genuine one.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.0144 dated 18.12.2019 registered at Police Station Tarsikka, District Amritsar Rural, under Sections 452, 324, 295, 506, 148, 149 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioners.
