1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. CRM-M No.14458 of 2020 was dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 24.06.2020, with liberty to the petitioner to take out appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law, at the appropriate stage.
3. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. with liberty to approach the learned trial Court, in accordance with law and directions being issued to the learned trial Court to decide the application for regular bail, as expeditiously as possible.
