All the cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

By this petition, filed under the provisions of Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to consider her request for her transfer/adjustment as an ETT Teacher in the Government Primary School, Partap Nagar, Patiala-3, where she was earlier transferred/posted vide an order dated 28.12.2016 (copy Annexure P-1) against a regular sanctioned vacant post.

In respect of her grievance of not being posted to the place where somebody else is now being posted, with the petitioner earlier having been refused permission to join that school (on the ground that there are less number of students), she is stated to have made a representation to respondent no.2, which is stated to have still not been decided.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the

competent authority amongst the respondents to take a decision on the aforesaid representation of the petitioner, by passing a detailed speaking order, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If a completely detailed speaking order has already been passed by the competent authority, then only a short order would now be needed to be passed, annexing therewith the detailed order already passed (if any).
