The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing in the light of the pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for quashing the impugned Notification No.S.O.74/P.A. 17/1887/S.5/2019 dated 6.11.2019 (Annexure P1), whereby village of the petitioners, namely Dhanauri, has been shifted from District Jind to District Kaithal without following the due procedure in this regard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 – Principal Secretary to Govt. Development and Panchayats Department, Haryana to take a final view on the Resolution dated 20.11.2019 (Annexure P2).

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has already been handed over to the learned State counsel.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 – Principal Secretary to Govt. Development and Panchayats Department, Haryana to take a final view on the Resolution dated 20.11.2019 (Annexure P2) in accordance with law within six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
