The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of FIR No.55 dated 08.03.2018 under Sections 452/380/323/324/427/148/506 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, "IPC") registered at Police Station Jamalpur, District Ludhiana on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 19.07.2019, the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording of their statements qua compromise and the case was adjourned to 14.11.2019 for awaiting the report of the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court.

As per report dated 05.09.2019 sent by the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana none of the parties appeared before him for getting their statements recorded.

Vide order dated 21.11.2019, the parties were again directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording

of their statements and the case was adjourned to 17.12.2019 for awaiting report.

As per report dated 02.12.2019 of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana, the parties did not appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording of their statements in compliance with order dated 21.11.2019 passed by this Court.

None had appeared for the petitioners on the last date of hearing. None has appeared for the petitioners even today. In these facts and circumstances, it appears that no compromise has actually been arrived at between the parties and the petitioners are not interested in further pursuing the present petition. Therefore, the present petition is dismissed in default for non-prosecution.
