On 21.10.2020, the following order was passed by this

Court:-

“The petitioners pray for grant of pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No. 191 dated 02.10.2020, registered under Section 354, 323 & 34 IPC at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioners and the first informant are related to each other. In fact, petitioner No.2-Ashwani Kumar is husband's brother of the first informant, whereas petitioner No.1-Sneha alias Rajinder Kumari alias Rajwinder Kumari is wife of petitioner No.2. They all are residing in the same house.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that there is delay of five days in registration of the case and the petitioners are being falsely implicated as the first informant wants to grab the front portion of the joint property.

Notice of motion.

On the request of the Court, Mr. Chetan Shrma, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and prays for time to seek instructions.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is considered appropriate that let the petitioners join investigation.

In the event of arrest of the petitioners, they shall be released on interim pre-arrest bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

List on 30.10.2020.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Amanpreet, has submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation, cooperated and are not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 21.10.2020, is hereby made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
