On 21.10.2020, the following order was passed:-

“The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No.195 dated 28.07.2020 registered under Sections 323, 34, 506 (307 and 325 added later on) of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Sadar Dadri, District Charkhi Dadri.

As per the case of the prosecution, there is a piece of land which is owned jointly by the brothers and when Rajbir was raising construction, a fight took place between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the parties have entered into a settlement. He draws attention of the Court to Annexure P-3, the settlement deed.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Vikrant Pamboo, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of State of Haryana and seeks time to get instructions.

Ms. Veena Hooda, Advocate appears for the first informant and admit the correctness of the aforesaid statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Adjourned to 29.10.2020.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Mr. Chetan Sharma, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has submitted that the petitioner in this case has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the statement made by Sh. Chetan Sharma, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, the interim order dated 21.10.2020, passed by this Court is made absolute qua petitioners also.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
