Petitioner has approached this Court highlighting therein that she is being forced to get married despite the fact that she is only 16 years of age and wants to continue her studies. The allegations have been made against respondents No. 5 and 6 in particular.

Highlighting this aspect, petitioner has submitted a representation dated 01.10.2020 (Annexure P-3) to The Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra as well as The Station House Officer, Police Station Babain, District Kurukshetra, respondents No. 2 and 3 respectively.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to The Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra as well as The Station House Officer, Police Station Babain, District Kurukshetra, respondents No. 2 and 3 respectively to look

into the representation dated 01.10.2020 (Annexure P-3) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner and without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to The Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra as well as The Station House Officer, Police Station Babain, District Kurukshetra, respondents No. 2 and 3 respectively to look into the representation dated 01.10.2020 (Annexure P-3) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.
