The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking directions to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) to provide photocopies of evaluated answer-sheets of Social Science and Science papers of the petitioner. The said answer-books relate to class 10 examination taken by the petitioner in March, 2018.

In my considered view, the petitioner is not going to derive any benefit, at this stage, even if, the photocopies of the answer-sheets are made available to him. He would soon be taking class 12 examination. The class 10 score is relevant only for taking admission in class 11. That stage has gone past two years back and issuance of any directions, at this stage, would amount to issuance of a futile writ. It is settled law that futile writs will not be issued.

Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed.
