On 21.10.2020, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“The petitioners pray for grant of pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No.233 dated 7.9.2020 registered under Section 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Verowal, District Tarn Taran.

Dispute in the present case is with respect to validity and genuineness of a registered Will executed by Gurdial Singh on 6.5.2016 in favour of his grandsons namely Inder Mohan Singh and Amarjot Singh.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that petitioner no.1 is scribe whereas petitioner no. 2 to 4 are witnesses to the registered Will. He further submits that the validity of the aforesaid Will has never been challenged. He also submits that the petitioners are not the beneficiaries of the aforesaid Will.

Notice of motion.

On the request of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab and prays for time to seek instructions.

Adjourned to 30.10.2020.

Keeping in view the facts of the case, this Court is of the considered view that let the petitioner join investigation.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Ms. Samina Dhir, DAG, Punjab, on instructions from SI Rajinder Singh, has stated that the petitioners have joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, the order dated 21.10.2020 passed by this Court is ordered to be made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
