Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of concession of anticipatory bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No.126 dated 30.9.2020 registered under Sections 323, 427, 354, 354-A, 379A, 506 & 509 of IPC at Police Station-Women Police Station, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, prays for permission to withdraw the petition. He, however, submits that the petitioner is to appear in the LL.B. examination on 23.10.2020. Hence, he restricts his prayer to grant protection to the petitioner for a period of two days.

Mr.Vikrant Pamboo, DAG, Haryana opposed the prayer.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances, this Court is of a considered view that the limited relief sought by the petitioner deserves to be granted.

Hence, while dismissing the petition as withdrawn, the arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed upto 5:00 PM on 23.10.2020.
