SUVIR SEHGAL, J.(ORAL)

The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.80 dated 05.10.2020, registered under Section 380 IPC, at Police Station Naya Gaon, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Vide order dated 23.10.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioners were released on interim bail and were directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Harjit Singh states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no longer required for custodial interrogation. He further points out that the petitioners are not involved in any other criminal case.

In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 23.10.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
