Petitioners apprehend threat to their lives and liberty from respondents No. 4 and 5 and have, therefore, highlighted this position in their representation dated 18.10.2020 (Annexure P-5) addressed to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, Chandigarh Police Headquarter, Sector-9, Chandigarh-respondent No.2.

Counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, Chandigarh Police Headquarter, Sector-9, Chandigarh-respondent No.2 and the Station House Officer, Police Station Sector 36, Chandigarh-respondent No. 3 to look into the representation dated 18.10.2020 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners and without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, Chandigarh Police Headquarter, Sector-9, Chandigarh-respondent No.2 and the Station House Officer, Police Station Sector 36, Chandigarh-respondent No. 3 to look into the representation dated 18.10.2020 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.
