The petitioner prays for protection of her life and liberty from respondent no.4 to 10.

It has been pleaded in the petition that she was married by the parents to a blind man against her wishes. She further claims that a child was also born out of the wedlock. However, thereafter, since she was physically and mentally harassed by her in-laws, therefore, she left her matrimonial home and came to her parental house. However, she was not permitted to live there. It is claimed that the petitioner is presently residing with someone and she now wants to study. It has further been pleaded that her parents are planning to sell her.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, learned counsel representing the State of Haryana was requested to verify the facts alleged.

Mr. Chetan Sharma, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, on instructions from ASI Narender, has informed the Court that the petitioner on her own, had married to a blind man and thereafter, walked out of

the matrimonial home. It is further stated that her parents have now made a statement that she has now chosen a wrong path and is living with a male friend. The parents have also stated that they are not interfering in the life of the petitioner.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is disposed of.
