AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that the minor son of the petitioner, namely Beerjotsingh, has been stated to be taken away by his father-in-law Niranjan Singh, mother-in-law Amarjeet Kaur and brother-in-law Gurnam Singh, residents of Bawakhel Gill River, Madhuban Colony, near Kapurthala Chowk, Thekkewali Gali, District Jalandhar.

It is asserted that the wife of the petitioner, namely Navpreet Kaur, with whom his marriage was solemnized on 18.07.2010, expired on 17.09.2020. On the same day, respondents No.4 to 6 had taken away the minor son of petitioner, namely Beerjotsingh, along with them. In this regard, a complaint was submitted by the petitioner to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana – respondent No.2, on 19.10.2020 (Annexure P-4) but till date, no action thereon has been taken. Earlier, mother of the petitioner, namely Smt. Amarjit Kaur, had approached the Station House Officer, P.S.

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Division No.6, Ludhiana, on 12.10.2020 (Annexure P-3) highlighting the same grievance but without any result.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana – respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 19.10.2020 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, with directions to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana – respondent No.2 to look into the representation 19.10.2020 (Annexure P-4) and take appropriate action in accordance with law, if required.
