Case has been heard through video conferencing on account of COVID-19 Pandemic.

The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No.13 dated 15.1.2019 registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, Section 13 of Punjab Prevention of Human Smuggling Act, 2012 and Section 24 of Immigration Act at Police Station Division No.7, Ludhiana.

After arguing for sometime, counsel for the petitioner has made request that he be allowed to withdraw this petition with liberty to surrender before the Illaqa Magistrate with direction to the said Court to decide his regular bail petition within 5 days of its presentation. Necessary permission is hereby granted.

Accordingly, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn. If the petitioner surrenders before the Court concerned within next 30 days from today, then his application for grant of regular bail be disposed of by the said Court, preferably within 5 days of its presentation, in accordance with law.
