Petitioners apprehend threat to their lives and liberty from respondent Nos.4 to 8 and have, therefore, highlighted this position in their representation dated 18.10.2020 (Annexure P-5) addressed to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar and Station House Officer, Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar-respondent No.3.

Counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar and Station House Officer, Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar-respondent No.3, to look into the representation dated 18.10.2020 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar and Station House Officer, Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar-respondent No.3. to look into the representation dated 18.10.2020 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.
