Petitioner-Nishant Ahuja through his special power of attorney has filed the instant petition seeking concession of bail in anticipation of arrest qua FIR No. 0166 dated 30.12.2019 registered at Women Police Station Gurugram for offence punishable under Sections 406, 498-A read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

A bare perusal of averments raised in the petition makes it evident that the petitioner is residing in Germany. On a pointed query, counsel for the petitioner would fairly concede that the petitioner has not fixed any schedule for coming to India. He would inform that due to *Covid-19*, there is no direct flight between Germany and India. As the petitioner is residing in Germany and there is nothing on record suggestive of the fact that any proceedings for his extradition have been initiated, there is no

question of any apprehension of the petitioner being arrested. In the given circumstances, the petitioner is not entitle to concession of bail in anticipation of arrest.

For the foregoing reasons, the petition is dismissed. However, in case the petitioner makes a schedule to come to India, he may take recourse to appropriate remedy in law.
