The matter is taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to COVID-19 situation.

The petitioners have approached this Court seeking protection of their life and liberty, pleading that petitioner Nos.1 and 2 have performed marriage against the wishes of respondent Nos. 4 to 8 and other relatives of the petitioner No. 1 and there is threat to their life and liberty.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Pawan Sharda, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No. 1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted a representation dated 20th October, 2020 (Annexure P-4) to the Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Amritsar seeking necessary protection, but no action has been taken so far in the matter.

Without examining the question of validity of marriage of the petitioners, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to the Senior

Superintendent of Police (Rural), Amritsar to look into the grievance of the petitioners expressed in the representation and take appropriate action, if so warranted.
