This appeal has been filed against the order of the learned Single Judge whereby even while issuing notice of motion, interim relief was declined to the appellant. Notice of motion. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Addl. A.G., Punjab with Ms. Monika Chibber Sharma, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accept notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel have agreed that the civil writ petition bearing CWP No. 24036 of 2016 fixed on 11.12.2020 and another civil writ petition bearing CWP No.17013 of 2020 filed by the caveator fixed for 12.1.2021 be finally heard on 10.11.2020. It has been further agreed that the written statements in both the abovesaid writ petitions (in case required) would be filed on or before 3.11.2020 and replication, if any, be filed on or before 9.11.2020 with

advance copy to the opposite side. All learned counsel have agreed that they would be prepared to argue both the writ petitions finally on 10.11.2020.

In these circumstances, both the abovementioned civil writ petitions are preponed to 10.11.2020.

In view of the above agreement, the present appeal is dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
