The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner-wife submits that there is matrimonial dispute of the petitioner with respondent No.4-husband. The petitioner has left the matrimonial house and came to her parents home. The husband along with his relatives have threatened the petitioner but the police is not taking any action.

On specific enquiry during the arguments as to which police station, the petitioner approached for lodging an FIR, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that petitioner will approach the concerned police station. He prays that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.

Mr. H.S. Sitta, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, appearing on advance notice, submits that in case the petitioner approaches the concerned police station with a complaint against respondent No.4 and his relatives, same would be looked into in accordance with law and necessary action, if any, would be taken expeditiously.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
