Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent Nos. 5 to 9.

On 27.10.2020, learned counsel for the petitioner has sought time to establish that petitioner was given an injury at the hands of respondent No. 5 and again on 04.11.2020, time was sought by him to place on record the MLR.

Reply, by way of affidavit of DSP, Sub Division City, District Hoshiarpur, has been filed in Court today and as per reply, on a complaint given by the petitioner, inquiry was marked to DSP, Crime Against Women and Children, Hoshiarpur and during inquiry, the DSP has given a notice to petitioner but she failed to appear and support her contentions. Accordingly, a report was submitted to SSP, Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly conceded that there

is no MLR of the petitioner to show that the injury was caused by respondent No. 5.

In view of the above, no further action is called for in the present petition and the same is disposed of.

However, liberty is granted to petitioner to file a complaint before the Illaqua Magistrate, if so advised.
