On 27.10.2020, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No.92 dated 13.09.2020, registered under Section 323 324, 452, 506, 148 & 149 IPC (Section 325 IPC was added lateron) at Police Station Singh Bhagwantpur, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner draws attention of the Court to the order passed by this Court in Shyam Singh @ Shyam Lal v. State of Punjab (Criminal Misc. No. M-33900 of 2020) granting interim protection to the co-accused.

Ms. Samina Dhir, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab has admitted the fact that there is version and cross-version

and no specific role has been attributed to the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On the request of the Court, Ms. Samina Dhir, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and prays for time to seek instructions.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is considered appropriate that let the petitioner join investigation.

In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim pre-arrest bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

List on 30.10.2020 along with Criminal Misc. No. M-33900 of 2020.”

Ms. Samina Dhir, DAG, Punjab, on instructions from ASI Harbans Singh, has stated that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, the order dated 27.10.2020 passed by this Court is ordered to be made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
