Short reply filed on behalf of respondent No. 3 is taken on record.

Prayer of the petitioner in this case was to direct the Punjab Nursing Registration Council, the third respondent herein, to consider her claim for Assured Career Progression scales on completion of four years service as a Superintendent (Grade-II) and also to promote her to the post of Superintendent (Grade-I).

Reply filed by respondent No. 3 demonstrates that the petitioner was promoted as a Superintendent (Grade-I) in March 2018, after institution of this writ petition.

Mr. J.S. Rattu, learned counsel for respondent No. 3, would assure this Court that the petitioner's claim for grant of Assured Career Progression scales would be considered on its own merits and in

accordance with law within a time frame.

Taking note of the aforestated promotion already granted, as well as the submissions made, the writ petition is disposed of directing respondent No. 3 to consider the petitioner's claim for Assured Career Progression scales and take a decision thereon expeditiously and in any event, not later than four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
