Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.265 dated 14.09.2020 registered under Sections 323, 379, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar, District Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that as per the allegations in the FIR, the complainant Amandeep Singh had a money dispute with the co-accused Sajan and on that account, Sajan along with the petitioner and other accused have caused him injuries. It is further submitted that as per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner had caught hold the complainant whereas Sajan and Ravinderpal Singh, took his mobile phone and Rs.45,000/- in cash. It is also submitted that in fact one more FIR No.195 dated 19.09.2020, was registered against the father of the complainant in which he already stands arrested.

Counsel for the State could not dispute the aforesaid facts and submits that the petitioner has caught hold the complainant.

After hearing the counsel for the parties, considering the

allegations against the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer within a period of 10 days from today, to join the investigation and he shall be released on interim bail on furnishing bail/surety bonds, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
