RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.

[1]. Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.26 dated 12.12.2017 registered under Sections 7,13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act at Police Station Vigilance Bureau Range Ferozepur along with all subsequent proceedings undertaken in pursuance thereof.

[2]. Perusal of the record would show that though the complaint made by Tilak Raj ultimately resulted in settlement between the parties, but owing to the allegation of demand made by the petitioner from Parminder Singh, a complaint was made by Parminder Singh/respondent No.2 which ultimately led

to a raid by a team constituted for that purpose and the petitioner was caught in the trap laid by the police.

[3]. At this stage, petitioner cannot doubt evidentiary value of different participating members of the raiding party, who have played definite role being officials.

[4]. No ground is made out to interfere in this petition. This petition is accordingly dismissed.
