Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of impugned order dated 29.09.2015 (Annexure P-6), whereby he has been declared proclaimed offender and all subsequent proceedings arising out of the FIR No.45 dated 28.02.2015, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 419 and 120-B IPC, 1860 and Sections 65, 66 and 66-A Information Technology Act, 2000, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

On 12.12.2019, the following order was passed by the Court:

“Contends that petitioner is ready to join the proceedings before learned trial Court.

Notice of motion for 26.02.2020.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before learned trial Court. On his doing so, he shall be released on interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing subject to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in compliance of the order dated 12.12.2019, the petitioner submitted himself before the trial Court on 07.01.2020. He has produced the copy of the order dated 07.01.2020 passed by trial Court, whereby the petitioner was released on interim regular bail.

Learned counsel for the complainant and learned State counsel do not dispute the above fact and state that the petitioner submitted himself before the trial Court on 07.01.2020 and furnished the bail bonds and surety bonds.

Considering the above, the impugned order dated 29.09.2015 declaring the petitioner proclaimed offender is set aside. Further, the petitioner be allowed to remain on the bail bonds and surety bonds furnished by him before the trial Court on 07.01.2020.

The petition is allowed.
