The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.33 dated 17.04.2016 under Section 18 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Ajitwal, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in terms of order dated October 29, 2020, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial court and has been admitted on bail. He has also deposited a sum of Rs.10,000/- as costs with the Welfare Fund of the Bar Association, District Court Moga.

Since pursuant to the order dated October 29, 2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial court and has been

admitted on *interim bail*, the present petition is disposed of, at this stage and

the order dated October 29, 2020, is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to appear before the trial court to face trial as and when required, in accordance with law.
