1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating action against the respondents for not complying with the order of this Court (Annexure P-1) dated 13.09.2019 passed in CWP No.23399 of 2019 in case titled as 'Dr. Sandeep Kharb versus The Board of Governors and others'.
3. Learned counsel contends that CWP No.23399 of 2019 was disposed of vide order (Annexure P-1) dated 13.09.2019 by directing the respondents to decide the claim made in the legal notice dated 09.08.2019 within 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order but despite lapse of aforementioned period of time, needful has not been done, till date.
4. Notice to the respondents to show cause as to why proceedings under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 be not initiated against them for

non-compliance with the orders of this Court dated 13.09.2019 in CWP No.23399 of 2019.

5. Mr. Vivek Chauhan, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has produced a copy of order dated 08.11.2019 passed in compliance of order dated 13.09.2019 in CWP No.23399 of 2019. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner on perusal of order dated 08.11.2019, prays for permission to withdraw the contempt petition with liberty to challenge order dated 08.11.2019, in accordance with law.

7. ***Dismissed as withdrawn*** with the liberty, as prayed for.
