In the present writ petition, the challenge is to order dated 27.03.2020 (Annexure P/10), by which the petitioner, who is working in Border Security Force has been transferred to Rajasthan Frontier . Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that though, the petitioner has no objection for serving anywhere in the country wherever he is required for, but, keeping in view the fact that his 20 years old daughter, who is 90% disabled needs his continuous attention and as the petitioner will not be allotted an accommodation by the respondents in the Battalion so as to keep his family alongwith him, his transfer as effected vide order dated 27.03.2020 (Annexure P/10), be set aside.

This Court passed an order that grievance of the petitioner with regard to allotment of an accommodation in the Battalion where he has been

transferred so as to keep his family along with him, be considered by the appropriate authorities and an appropriate order be passed on the said plea.

Today, learned counsel appearing for the respondents has placed on record order dated 17.12.2020, wherein, it has been mentioned that the prayer of the petitioner for allotment of Government accommodation as per his entitlement at 125 Bn BSF for accommodating his family including his 20 years old daughter, who is 90% disabled near his workplace, has been allowed and a direction has also been issued that a quarter be allotted at Battalion location, where the petitioner has to join. The said order is taken on record. Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that even vide order dated 21.12.2020, the quarter has already been allotted to the petitioner and the possession of the same will be given to the petitioner immediately upon his joining to the said place.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the said orders placed on record by the learned counsel for the respondents, the grievance of the petitioner, as raised in the present petition, stands redressed and he does not want to press the present writ petition any further and the same may be disposed of as such.

The present petition is disposed off having been not pressed.
