HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.

In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that he was entitled for the benefit of judgment rendered by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in **State of Punjab and another vs. Nirmal Singh and another** (SLP (Civil) No.10098 of 1997 decided on 6.11.1998) (Annexure P/6) for recalculating his pensionary benefits.

Learned counsel for respondent No.1 has stated on bar that relief, which is being claimed in the present writ petition, has already been allowed by the respondents vide order dated 14.01.2020 and the pensionary benefits of the petitioner have been revised and revised pension payment order has also been released in favour of the petitioner. Copy of the order dated 14.01.2020 has been handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that though, the relief which

is being claimed in the present writ petition has been allowed, but the actual relief in pursuance to order dated 14.1.2020 is yet to be released by the respondents.

Learned counsel for respondent No.1 states that all the consequential benefits including the arrears, for which the petitioner becomes entitled in pursuance to order dated 14.01.2020 will be extended to the petitioner within a period of six weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that keeping in view the undertaking given by learned counsel for respondent No.1, he does not wish to press the present writ petition any further and the same may be disposed of as having been not pressed.

Ordered accordingly.
