This is third application filed by the petitioner for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.17, dated 21.01.2019, registered under Sections 15/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

While dismissing a previous petition the following order was passed:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising out from FIR No.17, dated 21.01.2019, registered under Sections 15/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

As per the case of the prosecution, petitioner was found in conscious possession of 150 Kg of poppy husk.

This court has heard learned counsels for the parties

at length and with their able assistance gone through the paper book.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated due to a property dispute and the vehicle through which the narcotics were brought does not belong to the petitioner.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State has submitted that huge quantity of narcotics have been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner who was found sitting on 5 bags full of poppy husk, total weighing 150 Kg.

Keeping in view the facts of the case and bar to grant of bail as provided under Section 37 of the NDPS Act, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner failed to draw attention of the Court to any change in the circumstances.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
